SWISS STEAM LOCOMOTIVE GB A 3/5 SÉRIE 201-230 SBB-CFF A 3/5 SÉRIE 901-930



A bit of history...

The A 3/5 series 200 locomotive was presented at the 1896 National Exhibition in Geneva. Locomotive No. 202 was a testament to the expertise of the Swiss industry at the time.

The Gotthardbahn (GB) ordered 28 locomotives from the Schweizerische Lokomotiv- und Maschinenfabrik in Winterthur (SLM). These machines were delivered in four stages between 1897 and 1905. The first series locomotives were put into service from the depots at Erstfeld, Bellinzona, and Biasca, mostly to haul the famous luxury train composed of blue carriages (GB train). This train held the same prestige as the renowned Orient Express and was known to luxury clientele across Europe.

After the takeover by the SBB-CFF, the A 3/5 locomotives were renumbered as the "series 900". They were withdrawn from service around 1926, partly sold abroad or scrapped. Unfortunately, none of these machines were preserved.


